The Board reviewed the agenda and resolutions.

Clerk/Treasurer Johnson reviewed the upcoming bond sale, the final bill from the Sewage Treatment Plant and the budget adjustments on the agenda. Approximately \$44,000 was earned at the County Auction – most of that was from DPW items.

The Board met with Director of Public Services Robert Bennett and Mr. Mike Hoffmeier to discuss an issue with unfished site work at Mr. Hoffmeier's property at 753 Harry L. Drive. Mr. Hoffmeier has a tenant that needs to move in by November 1, 2015. They Board agreed to Mr. Hoffmeier posting a bond for the unfinished work.

The Board and Mr. Bennett also discussed the resolution for 220 Arthur Ave. for forgiveness of the sewer charges on the bill and an issue with the JSTP regarding keys for diesel fuel.
