Mayor Deemie called the meeting to order at 5:31pm.

Dai Korba discusses the following:

- New summer intern has been hired who is also the new Zombie Properties Clerk. Some of her hours are paid through her experience through us and will only require us monitoring her. The other portion is paid through the Zombie Grant Program. End of the summer she will be given her school credit and she will remain as Zombie Clerk into fall and possibly into the spring. We have another year on the grant unless they extend it.
- Interns are also funded through the Zombie program.

- We have not heard any information on the Greater Binghamton Fund
- We did not get selected for DRI for \$10 million for downtown. Binghamton Ithaca and Owego were selected.
- Consolidated Funding for Arch and restoration

Replacement of Lt. O'Hara as a police officer – will be hiring off Civil Service List.

Traffic Circle – Department of Transportation is going to be resurfacing and they want to fix circle. Village of Johnson City maintains the circle according to the DOT.

Levee analysis – levees don't meet code for flood requirements – some residents may get hit with flood insurance.
