

Binghamton University to host town hall to discuss new Health Sciences Campus

The University's new Health Sciences Campus in Johnson City is well underway. In addition to the new building that will open in 2018 to house the School of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, the Decker School of Nursing will relocate from the main University campus in Vestal to a renovated former Endicott Johnson factory building on the new campus in Johnson City.
